Abandoned Well Sealing and Shock Chlorination Programs Terms & Conditions

Objective:

- To help maintain the groundwater quality
- The removal of a hazard to people and livestock
- Improve quality of drinking water

Eligibility:

- Location of well must be within the La Salle Redboine CD

Roles and Responsibilities:

The Applicant Shall:

- Request assistance by the proper application, which is to be received at the Conservation District office;
- **Allow consent of entry onto property for purposes of the project;**
- Provide access for inspection or evaluation by the Board at any reasonable time;
- Not alter, change, remove or modify the project without written consent of the District;
- Allow District to place signage at project site for CD contribution to project; signage removal must be approved by the Conservation District prior to removal; and
- **Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.**

The CD Shall:

- Determine application priorities in consultation with the Sub-District and Board;
- Reserve the right to reasonable access to project areas for tours or to inspect the condition of the project site;
- Will provide materials necessary for sealing and disinfecting wells;
- Arrange for necessary equipment for excavation;
- Supervise project to ensure well is properly sealed;
- La Salle Redboine Conservation District will not be held responsible for unforeseen complications or incidents which may occur as a result of the Well Shock Chlorination process.

Project Funding/Cost-Sharing/Incentives:

The Landowner will pay \$125 per well filled. Costs normally associated with well filling process, i.e. bentonite clay, disinfectant, fill materials etc. will be covered by the Conservation District. Other costs not normally associated with well filling will be covered 100% by the landowner. (eg. recovering cement blocks, removing debris from site etc.)

The Landowner will pay \$100 per well shocked. Costs normally associated with shock chlorination process, i.e. disinfectant, rental of tank, pump, hoses, etc... will be covered by the Conservation District. Other costs not normally associated with shock chlorination will be covered 100% by the landowner.
