



## Relocation Of Livestock Confinement Facilities Top-up

**Objective:**

- To reduce contaminant levels from point sources of pollution, and reduce stream bank degradation and soil and vegetation loss for the purposes of protecting water quality for downstream users.

**Eligibility:**

- All applications must be made out in the Landowner's name;
- All lands must be located within the La Salle Redboine Conservation District;
- Provide a Certificate of Completion from the Canada-Manitoba Farm Stewardship Program (CMFSP) or current equivalent;

**The Applicant shall:**

- Complete the appropriate application form and submit to the Conservation District office;
- Provide consent of entry for project assessment, construction, inspection, and maintenance;
- Provide sufficient room for construction;
- Not remove, destroy, or alter the structure for a period of 10 (ten) years without prior authorization of the Conservation District;
- Allow the Conservation District to place signage indicating CD involvement at the project site. Permission required to move or remove signs;
- Indemnify and save harmless the Conservation District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation, or maintenance of the project;
- Allow LSRBCD to conduct educational tours of the project site.

**The CD shall:**

- Provide a site inspection prior to commencement of project;
- Provide construction advice as per industry accepted Best Construction Management Practices;
- Provide project implementation assistance;
- Inspect periodically.

**General Terms and Conditions:**

- Failure of a Landowner to meet Landowner responsibilities may negate their eligibility for other District Programs.
- All practices eligible for funding and associated costs must comply with CMFSP, or current equivalent, BMP 6 Relocation of Livestock Confinement Facilities conditions.
- Technical service and financial assistance for project construction will be subject to the availability of staff and funding. The District reserves the right to establish priorities for providing such services and assistance;
- Under special circumstances, the District may consider applications which do not meet all the requirements of CMFSP, or current equivalent, for reduced funding.

**Project Funding/Cost-sharing/Incentives:** Financial support for the Relocation of Livestock Confinement Facilities Program will be 20% Conservation District funding to a maximum \$20,000 on the landowner's portion of the project costs, per project.
