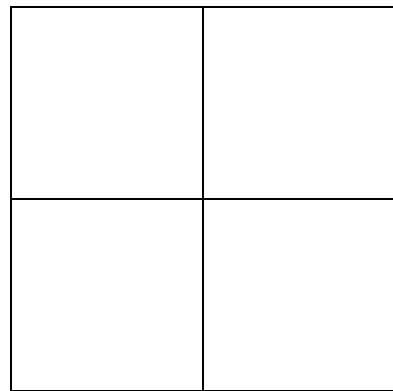

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Pasture Pipeline Plow Rental Program Agreement

Objective:

- To provide an alternative livestock watering source for pasture managers.

Eligibility:

- For an area to qualify for pasture pipeline plow rental, land must be within the La Salle Redboine Conservation District.

Roles and Responsibilities:

The Applicant Shall:

- Request assistance by application, which is to be received at the Conservation District office;
- Provide consent of entry for inspection and construction;
- Provide sufficient room for construction;
- Allow District to conduct tours of the project site;
- Provide tractor for plowing water lines into ground;
- Pay for damages caused to plow by negligent use;
- Allow District to place signage at project site for CD contribution to project; signage removal must be approved by the Conservation District prior to removal; and
- **Landowner must also show proof of easements and approvals to proceed from all utilities; and arrange for locates if necessary;**
- **If damage to a utility cable occurs, the landowner will accept responsibility and the Conservation District can not be held liable; and**
- Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.
- Pay the Conservation District \$150/day for use of plow.



The CD Shall:

- We will deliver the plow;
- Provide a technician to assist with assembly and technical assistance;
- We will also help design the path of pipe and using GIS and GPS equipment, provide a detailed ortho-rectified map of the pipeline course;
- Supervise project to ensure project design is met;
- Provide an avenue to pipe and connectors. (i.e. list of wholesalers)
